Sub: Scheme for grant of Special Award to Meritorious children of our employees

As per extant provisions under the scheme for grant of special award to meritorious children of our employees, the monetary award on passing the Board level examination has been linked to the percentage of marks secured i.e.60%, 70%, 80% & 90%.

Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has introduced 'Grading system' (in lieu of numerical marking mode) at Secondary School level for class IXth & Xth Board examination from the academic year 2009-10. The performance as per the revised format is assessed using conventional numerical marking mode, and the same is then converted into the grades on the basis of the pre-determined marks range. Accordingly, students are awarded CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) based on their subject wise performance. As per the CBSEs circular no. 24 dated 28.5.10, the overall indicative percentage (%) of marks would be computed as **9.5 x CGPA**.

In view of Grading system, the existing criteria for reward amount has been modified and linked to CGPA for children qualifying secondary school level (class Xth) examination of the CBSE, as under:
